### **Research indicates:**

- 50% of individuals with auditory processing disorder (APD) experience significant anxiety

- Up to 55% of children referred for mental health services were diagnosed with a neurodevelopmental disorder

- Up to 70% of dyslexic readers have APD

- 79% of dyslexic readers have a vision problem

- 80% of children with processing issues experience mental health difficulties

- Auditory and visual processing problems mimic and co-occur with ADHD, autism, trauma, anxiety, depression, OCD, and learning disorders

- Strengths-based learning improves engagement,

perseverance, achievement, and well-being in students
